	lesson and pray for the teachers/kids. Each staff member should be able to
	devote 30 mins each week to prepare to lead discussion group, and will be
	responsible for additional preparation on weeks they are scheduled to teach or
	prepare the craft.

Description:	LKC is a midweek Bible study for children of families both within and outside of LBC. The goal of LKC is to provide a fun, safe environment in which children are taught the whole counsel of God's Word, exhorted to repent and turn to Christ in faith, and encouraged to live in obedience to God. We meet Thursday evenings, and have monthly staff meetings.
